

Unacceptable management offers

On May 26, the employer party filed its global offers with the goal of reaching a settlement. After analyzing these offers, the Federation can only come to one conclusion: the government literally lacks respect for the care professionals, as well as the whole population by persisting in not resolving the problems in the health network. It must be said that they are acting completely irresponsibly and continue to put the onus on the backs of the care professionals and to endanger the longevity of the public health network. The government is abandoning the Quebec population, that's all.

FIQ activists participate in quick action of the World March of Women

Because of the government's refusal to take a stand with the World March of Women, about one hundred activists from the World March of Women in Quebec participated in the operation *Déboucher les oreilles du gouvernement, suivons-le à la trace!*, on May 29, during which the World March of Women activists lined the pavement outside the National Assembly with red marks left by their shoes. It is important to remind the government that the World March of Women will be in the streets of Quebec in October and is expecting concrete responses. By choosing to leave red marks, the action is linked to the "Halte à Charest" campaign of the *Coalition opposée à la tarification et à la privatisation des services publics* (Coalition opposed to the pricing and privatization of public services).
