On November 26, before the members of the board of directors of the Agence de la santé et des services sociaux de la Montérégie, the community and labour organizations making up the Coalition Montérégie sans *PPP* reiterated their appeal for the public construction and management of CSHLD's in the region. They are demanding that the CHSLD Saint-Lambert-sur-le-Golf be taken over by public authorities and that the projects in Granby, Chateauguay and Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu be carried out by conventional methods, rather than as PPP's.
