This Haitian non-governmental organization works towards improving the maternal and child health of underprivileged families in the Croix-des-Bouquets region which is located near Port-au-Prince.

This financial support was enthusiastically welcomed by the H.E.L.P. organization which did not waste any time in investing in safely consolidating its welcoming infrastructures in



order to provide health care to mothers and children. The organization also set up cholera treatment units and is making home visits to the people of Croix-des-Bouquets to give them hygiene equipment.
