**The SPSICR and the FIQ meet with the DG and the president of the BD**

On April 19, a meeting took place between the representatives of the *Syndicat des professionnelles en soins infirmiers et cardiorespiratoires* (SPSICR), the FIQ vice-president and union consultant as well as the executive director and the president of the board of directors of the *CSSS Domaine-du-Roy*. The goal of that meeting was to establish a dialogue with the administration of the institution in order to resolve the problem of overtime hours accumulating.

Among the solutions proposed by the union representatives are an increase in the number of full-time positions and better planning of the schedules. Furthermore, an employer-union working committee will be set up.

Remember that on February 23, following a spontaneous work stoppage to denounce the untenable situation in the institution, about a dozen healthcare professionals in the emergency department refused to start their shift.

Last Friday, April 27, the *Coalition opposée à la tarification et à la privatisation des services publics*, in which the Federation takes part, reaffirmed its unqualified support of the students' strike. During a sit-out, it invited social groups and all citizens that feel affected by the student fight to come sit in front of the premier's offices in Montreal to demand real negotiations from him.

The Coalition recalled the importance of bringing the debate back to the main issue, access to education. The member groups of the Coalition continue to refuse any increase in tuition fees, because that will widen social inequalities in addition to trampling on the respect for the right to an education.
